APPENDIX: PROVISIONAL OR INDICATIVE CONTRIBUTIONS TO HELP DEAL WITH THE MPF DEFICIT

The annual figures provided by each trust are summarised below into totals for the periods 2021 to 2026 and 2027 to 2030.

The URC Trust paid £1.5 million into the MPF in 2019 in order to remove the possibility of a more prudent revaluation as at 2018 being imposed by the Pensions Regulator, which would have led to an immediate increase in the deficit and in the level of future service contributions. This £1.5 million is being treated as a contribution towards the £45 million target.

The increase in MPF future service contributions is likely to cause a deficit on the 2022 Ministry and Mission Fund of at least £1.5 million. This will have to be covered from the reserves of the URC Trust. Although not included in the schedule below, it does need to be recognised as a contribution by the URC Trust to the overall costs of the Church's provision of pensions.
